Legislative Council Types of Votes by District

The following table shows the types of votes recorded for all districts. The number of votes recorded for a district ranged from 8,110 for North West Central to 28,754 for Jandakot.

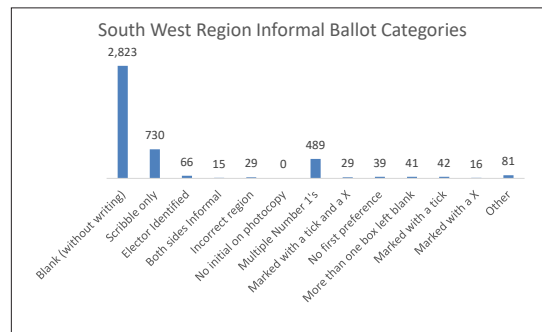
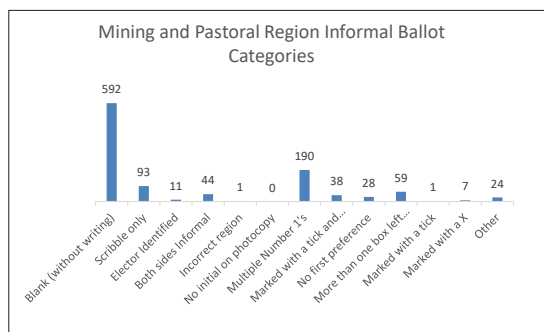
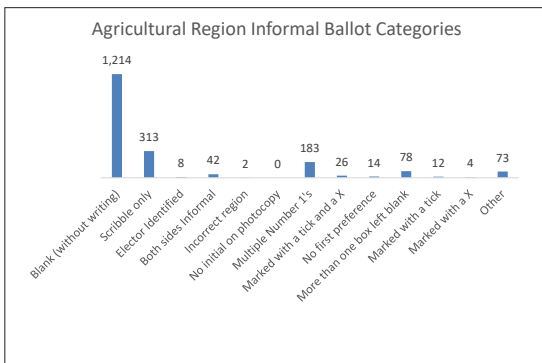
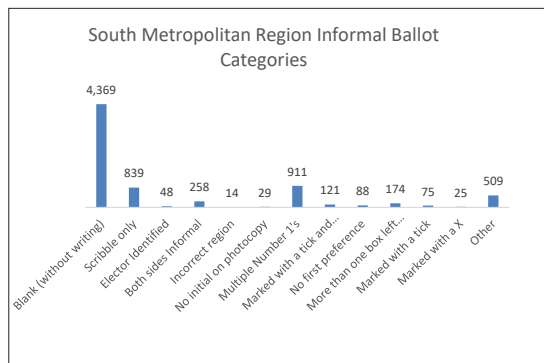
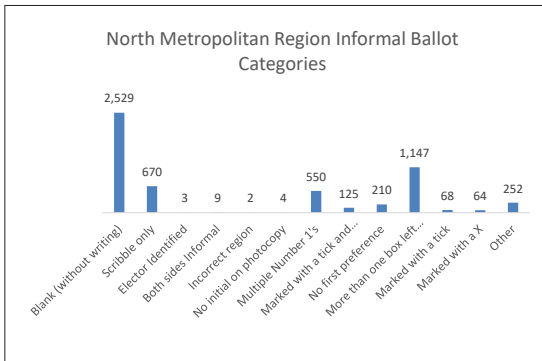
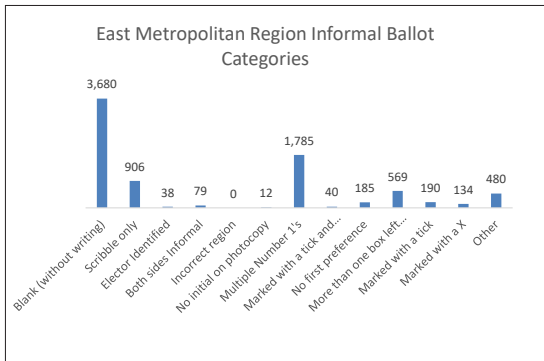
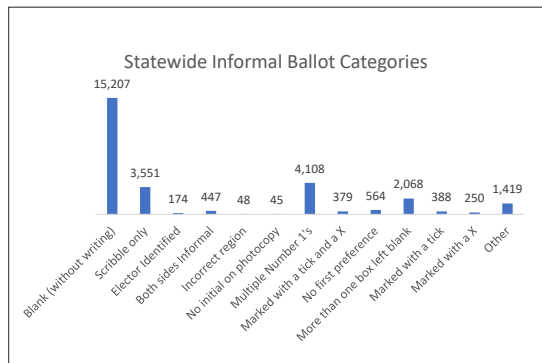
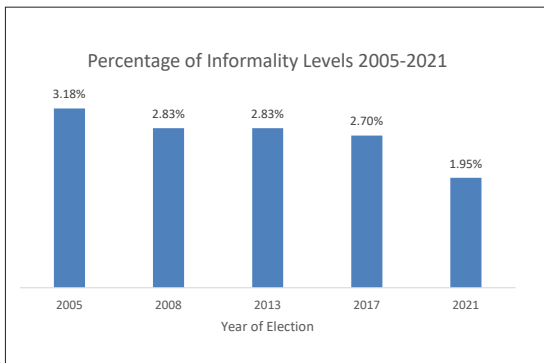
The Statewide average rate of informality for the Legislative Council decreased to 1.95% at this election.

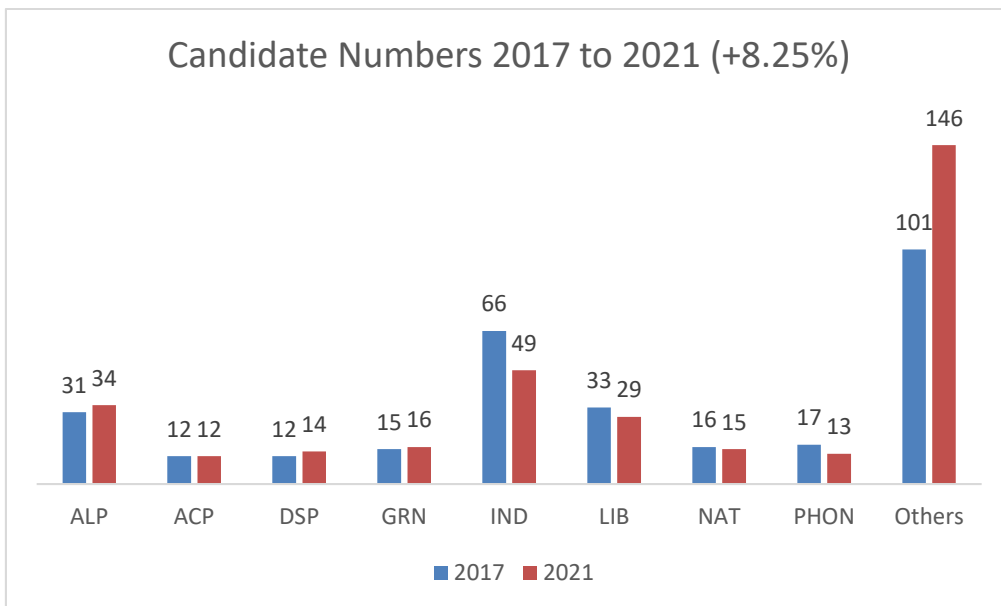
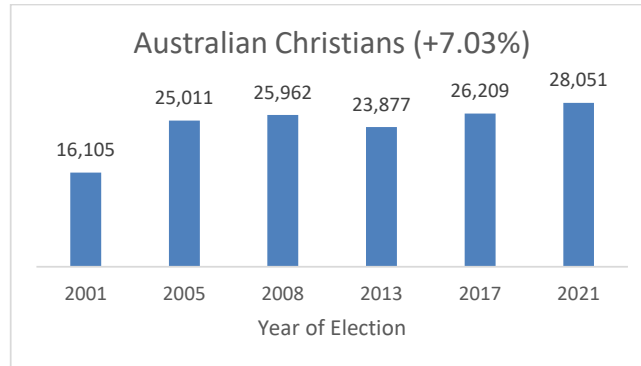
Balance of Power

WA Labor gained overall balance of power in the Legislative Council by winning an additional 8 seats, taking their total to 22.

Liberal Party lost 2 seats reducing their total to 7, The Nationals lost 1 seat reducing their total to 3, The Greens lost 3 seats reducing their total to 1 seat. Pauline Hanson's One Nation lost three seats, and the Liberal Democrats lost one seat. Legalise Cannabis Western Australia Party won two seats and Daylight Savings Party won one seat.

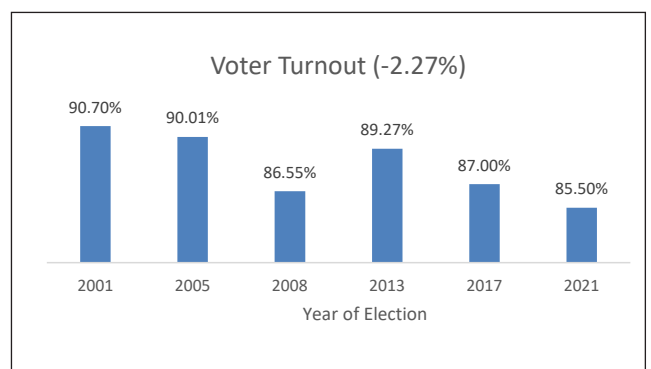
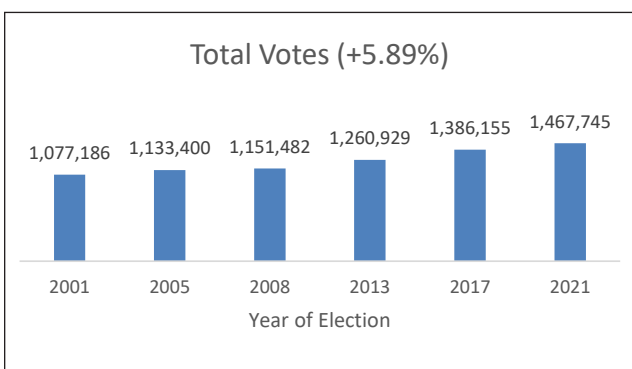
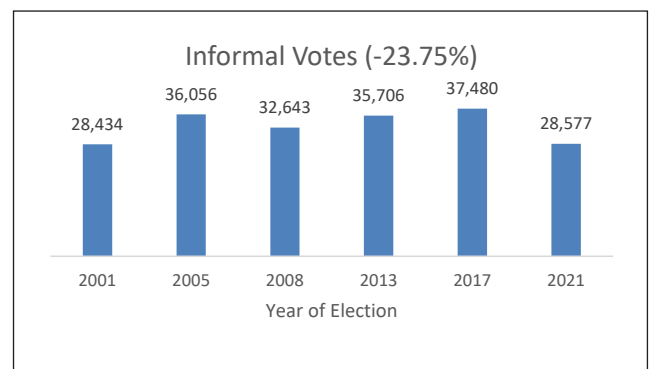
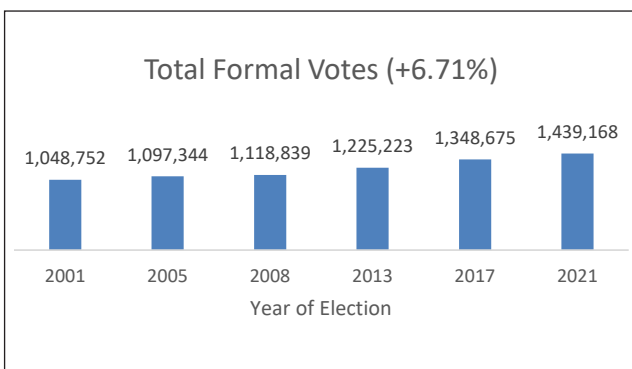
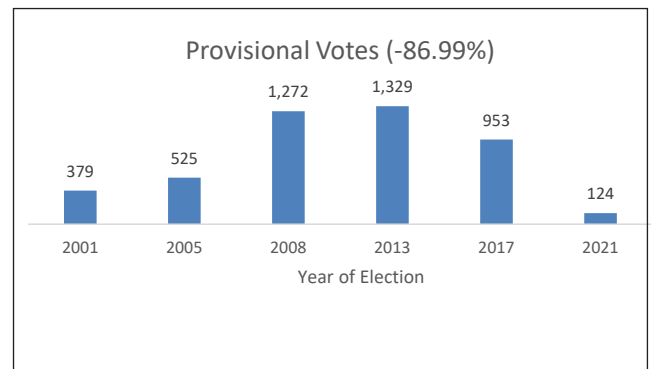
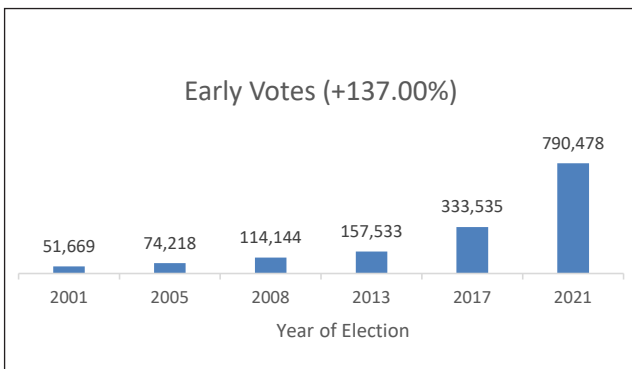
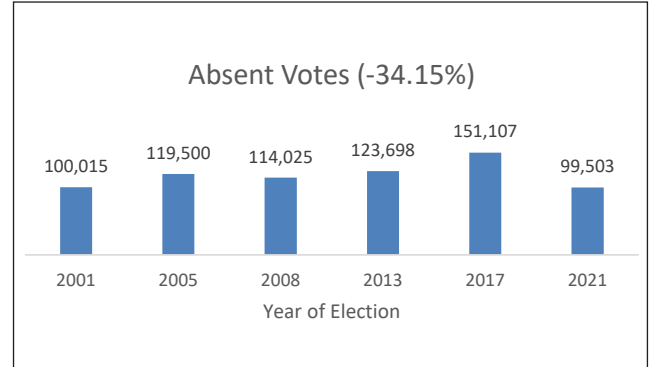
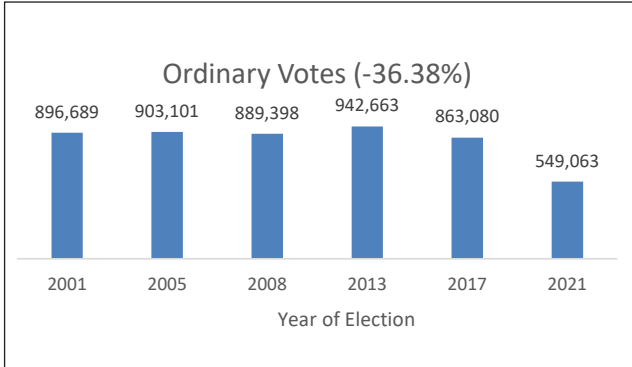




Legislative Council Type of Votes: Comparative Summary 2001 to 2021
