

<b>3</b>	<p><b>Recommendation</b></p> <p>Prior to every State election, WAEC produce a simple one-page brochure explaining the meaning and significance of voting “above the line” (ATL) and “below the line” (BTL); and preferential voting and have this available to all electors on Election Day at every State election.</p>

<b>4</b>	<p><b>Recommendation</b></p> <p>Prior to every State election, WAEC receive funding from the Department of Treasury and Finance to meet the cost of notifying by email if known and, if not, by mail, all electors affected by changes to electoral boundaries, and where they can go to cast an ordinary vote on Election Day.</p>
